



WILDERWOOD EQUINE THERAPY

EQUINE ASSISTANT VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

Parameters for this Volunteer Position may include any or all of the following:

- ☛ Assist and supervise participants to ensure equine safety protocols are adhered to
- ☛ Assist participants with grooming, feeding, and/or caring for the horses
- ☛ Participate as side-walkers for horse riding
- ☛ Assist participants prepare their horse for their equine activity
- ☛ Assist participants work safely with the horses on the ground
- ☛ Supervise participants for equine safety protocols in the pastures, Outback, or paddock
- ☛ Wash and/or groom the horses
- ☛ Exercising the horses, which may include walking, lungeing, or riding
- ☛ Teach equine assisted classes following the Wilderwood teaching protocols ¹
- ☛ Perform therapeutic treatments on the horses ²
- ☛ Supervise or perform the cleaning of tack and equipment
- ☛ Check feed provisions and making a list of needed equine feed supplies
- ☛ Clean buckets and/or feed bins
- ☛ Clean out/hosing down horse stalls
- ☛ Assist with manure clean-up and management
- ☛ Assist with storage of feed supplies (empty feed bags into containers, stack hay bales)
